PHOTOSHOP: SELECTION BASICS

DESCRIPTION:

The object of this lesson is to help you learn a few of the basic ways to *select* using Adobe Phtoshop. Also you'll learn how to color an inked graphic novel art using Photoshop.

First, review this project sheet and then view the videos linked at the end of this assignment. The first video gives a tour of working in Adobe Photoshop. The sceond reviews the assignment and demonstrates how to do it.

Next, download the Photoshop Basics supporting file. This is the image you'll use to practice your selections and then color the zebra finches.

You'll save your section work as a jpg and submit to Canvas.

1. Become very comfortable and familiar with selections in Adobe Photoshop.
2. Strive for impeccable craftsmanship.

5. Color the birds as described in the video.
